## BAMBINELLI' SUNDAY - 18<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER 2016

For the past several decades, each year on Gaudete Sunday, children and adults bring their baby Jesus figures from the crib at their homes to St. Peter's Square in Rome where the Holy Father blesses both the people and the figurines during the Angelus. This has become affectionately known as 'Bambinelli Sunday'.



This year we will celebrate 'Bambinelli Sunday' in our three parishes. Families are invited to bring the figure of the baby Jesus, that normally lies in the family crib, to the Mass that they will attend that weekend. The blessing will be given at each Mass on Saturday evening and on Sunday. A suggestion is, following the blessing, take your 'Bambinelli' home and place it in a gift box. Wrap it, and save it for Christmas. Let this be the first gift your family open on Christmas morning and together place the baby Jesus into the family crib. Say a prayer of blessing together asking God to protect your family and thanking God for the gift of His Son.
