Fr. Jackie Diamond Jubilee of Ordination

This weekend we join with the parishioners of Two Mile House, along with friends and parishioners of yesteryear in celebrating the Diamond Jubilee of Fr. Jackie's Ordination, sixty years ago! Ordained on Sunday 20th of June 1965. Jackie would probably consider Kilcock as home. Childhood saw Jackie and his family moving from one town to the next, his dad being a member of An Garda Siochana.

Likewise in priesthood Jackie had many diocesan appointments, including staff member of Knockbeg College for one year after Ordination. This was followed by some short and some longer

appointments: Birmingham, Ballyfin, Tullow, St. Mullins, Bagnalstown, Naas (1975-1989), Graignamanagh, Chaplain to the Defence Forces at the Curragh and then appointed Parish Priest of Caragh in 1995. Finally, in retirement, Jackie moved to Two Mile House in 2015.

It is here in Two Mile House that Jackie occupies a place of great affection in the hearts of all parishioners. Locals feel blessed that they can gather each morning for Mass with Fr. Jackie, the perfect start to their day, while also enjoying the social dimension of being together. Though retired Jackie takes a great interest in our local school, and often shares in the personal milestones of parishioners: Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals. Fr. Jackie is blessed with a wonderful memory and an ability to recall people and events from former years.

He epitomises all that is good in priesthood: dedication, faithfulness and unflinching commitment. He has a great capacity for friendship, for life and for people. Aside from his ministry as a priest, Jackie has always maintained a lively interest in an eclectic array of pastimes and hobbies: photography, music, golf and a keen knowledge of rare and wild flowers. In the latter he is recognised nationally as being something of an expert! An avid reader, with a keen curiosity about life, making him a great man for conversation. Since he arrived in 2015 Jackie has proved to be a wonderful colleague: obliging, helpful in every way. Always the kind word of encouragement. We deeply appreciate his loyalty, support and friendship.

Fr. Jackie, as parishioners and colleagues we join together in sending you our warmest best wishes and heartfelt congratulations, now that you have reached the milestone of your Diamond Jubilee. On an occasion like this, it is fitting that Bishop Denis joins us, giving due recognition and gratitude for a life of faithful service to our Diocese and to the Lord.




