Naas and Sallins Boxes of Envelopes for 2026

Boxes of envelopes are now available to collect from the Church porches along with forms which will allow the parish to claim back the tax on your donations.

If we could ask you to write your name and address on the first few envelopes which you use, this would allow us to keep a track of your donations during the year. If you donate more than €250 in any one year the parish can claim back the tax which you have already paid on this money.

It is a 'pain-free' scheme which in recent years has permitted the parishes to claim back over €210,000 from revenue.

If you think that you might not have written your name and address on the envelope for the current year, it is not too late! you can still write your name and address on your current envelope for the remaining weeks of 2025.
