Who is my neighbour?

The story of the Good Samaritan is probably the best know of Jesus' parables. Yet, regrettably, its message is not so well understood as to be always put into practice—even by Christians. "Who is my neighbour? Who belongs to the community of God?". These are the underlying questions in today's Gospel. Jesus' answer is contained in the parable of the Good Samaritan.

The parable tells the story of a man in distress. Two religious people- a priest and a Levite-pass him by. They probably did so with the best of religious intentions. Had they touched a corpse, they would, according to the Law, have become ritually unclean, and would have been unable to perform their religious duties. For them, religious purity ranked higher than compassion. So they pass the man by.

Along comes a Samaritan, someone considered by the Jews to be unholy and outside of God's love. He is moved by compassion to attend to the man in distress. By his compassionate actions, he proves to be the man's neighbour. He shows himself to be closer to God than the two good Jews who left the injured man by side of the road. The message of the parable is that anyone who acts as God acts, anyone who acts with compassion, is my neighbour and belongs to God's community. The keys to belonging to God are compassion and mercy.

In the story of the Good Samaritan, Jesus tells us very strongly that if we are to belong to him we must treat all those who need it with compassion and mercy. Ask a traveller, a refugee, a homeless person or any other excluded member of our society and they will tell you that they are not always received with the compassion and help that the Gospel demands.

The message today's Gospel hammers home to all of us is about being a neighbour to all without exclusion. It reminds us that if we do not love and care for our neighbour, irrespective of who that person is, then we cannot claim to be truly Christian. Challenging isn't it!!
