Happy St. Valentine's Day

Valentine was a priest who lived and worked in Rome in the 3rd Century A.D. The Roman Emperor at the time, Claudius, forbade young men to marry because he believed that single men made better soldiers. Valentine however, was more concerned about the care of the person and so he secretly married young couples.

Unfortunately, Valentine's caring and generous Spirit resulted in his arrest. Legend holds that during his imprisonment, Valentine sent messages to remind each of them how much he loved and cared about them. Whilst in prison Valentine experienced much torture and was later put to death. In honour of this brave and loving person, people remember and honour Valentine by sending cards and gifts expressions of our deep love for those near and dear to us.

Today's Gospel is also about love, the love of God for his people manifest in the coming of his Son, Jesus the Messiah.



"I have not come to abolish the Law and the prophets but to fulfil them" (Matt.5:17). By impressing upon the disciples that his mission is to fulfil the Law, Jesus teaches the need to form our hearts in the Law and in the love of God and neighbour. It is not enough for us to simply follow the Law. Instead we are asked to go beyond what it asks reaching out to others through the grace of the Holy Spirit and the love of God the Father. Christ's sacrificial, selfless, and unconditional love for each one of us is the love that we as Christians are called

to express in our own lives. 'This is my commandment: love one another as I have loved you' (John 15:12). Such love lies at the heart of our Christian belief, we call it *caritas* (loving-kindness, charity). May our daily lives be opportunities to explore the power of this great love.


