## Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year C) 13th June 2010

### SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN

Over the past year we have seen the publication of the *Ryan* and *Murphy* Reports. Both revealed a sad and painful period in the life of the Catholic Church in Ireland when the institution became more important than the people it was there to serve. Unfortunately we cannot change the past. However there is one thing we can change and that is to try our utmost to promote and implement measures that will ensure the safety and wellbeing of children in our parishes now and for the future.

In 2009 we had the publication of *Safeguarding Children, Policy and Procedures* for Kildare & Leighlin Diocese. This provides a definitive reference for all those working with children in our parishes and outlines best practice when working with children. This has practical implications for all of those working in our parishes as priests, paid employees or as volunteers. This weekend we are outlining the practical workings of the *Safeguarding Children, Policy and Procedures* in our parishes so that all parishioners can be fully informed of the measures we are implementing in Naas, Sallins and Two Mile House. These measures are as follows;

The publication of our *Parish Safeguarding Children Statement*, available in all our churches (see notice boards in churches and our parish website [www.naasparish.ie](http://www.naasparish.ie) under "Our Parish").

- The training and appointment of *Parish Designated Persons* in each of the three parishes. They are; Caroline Quinn (Naas), Sheila Pyke (Sallins) and Mary Valentine (Two Mile House). The role of the *Parish Designated Person* is to ensure good safeguarding practices for all those involved in parish ministries. There are other people who assist in this area and there are review meetings held at regular intervals. The five priests have also completed the training programme and have been Garda vetted.
