CHURCH RENOVATION: Work on the conservation and upgrading of St Peter's Church is now scheduled to take place during the months of May, June and July 2011. It is not possible to proceed during 2010 owing to the large number of weddings due to take place; (26 weddings from 26th Feb-16th Oct).
