

1st Sunday in Advent (Year C) 29th November 2009

Advent, a time of expectation and waiting...

In many ways Advent is the loveliest season of what we call the Church's year. It occurs during those hectic weeks before Christmas, when everything is in a rush and there is a sense of excitement in the air. If we try to enter the season of Advent, it will repay us abundantly, helping us to come to a deeper and more soundly based understanding of our Faith, and a better knowledge of that Person who was expected and who we believe has come as our Saviour.

There are two basic themes or ideas that are central to Advent. The first one is that of <u>Expectancy</u> and the second one is that of <u>Waiting</u>. In order to have this feeling of Expectancy, we must first be aware of the need for something, or someone new in our lives. We must have some sense of our emptiness, our inadequacy, maybe even our sinfulness. At the very least we must be aware of our need for some form of new life, of salvation. In truth, we are longing for a Saviour, and Advent tells us to look forward with hope to His coming.

The second big theme of Advent is Waiting. One of the striking images of Advent is Mary. She must have wondered about and longed for the birth of her child. She had to be patient. She had to wait. We too must learn patience in our dealings with God. We have to learn to wait, to get in time with the rhythm of God and adjust our lives to them. This is part of what we try to do in Advent.

THE ADVENT WREATH:

The Four Candles of the Wreath represent the four weeks of Advent and the thousands of years that the People of God awaited the promised messiah. The candles are purple in colour in reminder of the Spirit of Penance and prayer that marks the Advent Season. One of the Candles may be Rose for the Third Sunday of Advent, traditionally known as "Gaudete Sunday" from the opening words of that Sunday's Liturgy: "Rejoice in the Lord always". The round Wreath itself symbolises the eternity of God and the Father's presence throughout human history.
