THE NEW VISION OF PENTECOST

Imagine the scene, the disciples huddled together full of fear and anxiety when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, and they were filled with the Holy Spirit. This Spirit gave them the gift of speech so that people from every nation gathered in Jerusalem that day could hear the apostles speak in their own language. The disciples, who up to that moment were confused, frightened men, were transformed by God's Spirit. A new power took over their lives, a Spirit of boldness in giving witness to the Risen Christ. From that point on, nothing would be the same for them or for humanity again.

Surely the Church in Ireland has something to learn from this? When they were filled with the Holy Spirit, the apostles became new people, full of courage and conviction, happy to risk everything for the sake of the Gospel. Full of the Spirit, they could do anything.

It is true to say that we like people who are full of spirit. They have a zest about them, they are full of life, of energy, of enthusiasm, of commitment. People who are full of spirit don't quit easily. It's a quality every manager or coach wants in his or her team. A team that does not put in a spirited performance is one that is doomed to fail

The Church in Ireland is currently going through a difficult time of self reflection. As we acknowledge the wrongs of the past, which caused hurt to so many, a past we need to learn from, we also need to look to the future inspired by the same Spirit who lifted the disciples out of their fear and encouraged them go out to spread the Gospel. May we to fulfil this mission with enthusiasm and hope, knowing that the Lord's Spirit is with us all the way!
