The humble approach....

"O Lord it's so hard to be humble..." are the words of a song that could be applied to the Pharisees today. They must have been deeply annoyed and upset by the parable Jesus tells in today's Gospel. They realise it's directed at them.

At first glance, it might appear that following Jesus' recommendation to take the lowest place at a banquet or party would be merely a shrewd move to ensure you eventually got to the top. It seems like a clever strategy to adopt. After all, who does not like to be given a good seat? If it's a football match, we want a seat with a commanding view of the action, close to the centre line (like in Croke Park today!) If it's a concert or show, we want to be close to the front. Who doesn't want the best seat if they can get it?

But Jesus' parable is not to be interpreted as some smart piece of worldly wisdom. He is not advising on what etiquette to use at banquets or parties or anywhere else. He is talking about the position that each of us should adopt before God. He is saying that none of us should expect special recognition simply because we believe in the Gospel. He is saying that no matter who we are, or how religious we are, or how moral we might think we are, everything we have is a free gift from God, unmerited by us. Our approach must always be one of humility and gratitude.
