

# NAOMH BRÍD ......Muire na nGael St Brigid, Feast Day Monday 1st February 2010

According to tradition, St Brigid was born in the middle of the fifth century and from a young age was known to be very generous and kind to the poor. As news of her good works spread throughout Ireland, there was an increase at that time of young girls wishing to live like her, and so she decided to start a convent in County Kildare.

On making her decision she approached the king of Leinster for land to build the convent. Jokingly he responded 'I will give you as much land as your cloak can cover'. When Brigid spread her cloak on the ground, it grew and grew and grew, and soon there was more than enough land for her to build her convent on. The king came to realise the holiness of Brigid!!

Many of us have seen St Brigid's crosses hanging in homes, schools and churches in Ireland. They are usually placed by the door to protect the house from fire. We believe that St Brigid first weaved rushes into a cross when converting a dying pagan chieftain to Christianity and who consequently was baptised before his death.

**Help for Haiti....**just over two weeks ago we were saddened and horrified by the devastation left in the wake of the earthquake in Haiti. Since then many people in our parishes have responded so generously to various appeals to help those who are affected by this disaster. The 'Sisters of St Joseph of Cluny' are missionary sisters working on the ground in Haiti. One of their commitments is to feeding 400 children for the next six months in Haiti.

If you have not yet had the opportunity to contribute to the effort in Haiti, but would like to do so then there is an opportunity at next weekend's masses. We are inviting people to enclose a contribution in an envelope marked 'Haiti' and place in the baskets next weekend 6th/7th February. We will ensure that these contributions go directly to the 'Sisters of St Joseph of Cluny' relief efforts (without any administrative costs) so that some little comfort might come the way of those directly affected by this disaster.
