

St Brigid's Day - 1st February

According to tradition, this Feast of our Secondary Patron, Brigid of Kildare, is the first day of Spring in Ireland

What ever the weather take time to look around today at the beauty of God's creation in our landscape. Note how the birds singing brings hope that the lengthening of days lifts our spirits and winter woes begin to recede! We can offer our thanks to God that we live in such a beautiful, safe, free country where every tree represents that tree of Life on which our Saviour died for us.

Many of us have seen St. Brigid's Crosses hanging in homes, schools and Churches in Ireland. They are usually placed by the door to protect the home etc from fire. We believe that St Brigid first weaved rushes into a cross when converting a dying pagan to Christianity and who consequently was baptised before his death. We celebrate Brigid, a woman who lived the Gospel in such a profound way. May we be inspired by her life and try to follow her example of love and service in our lives.

As Lent approaches let us invoke Brigid for a renewal of Faith throughout the land of Ireland. We celebrate Catholic schools during the coming week and given the quality of education in all our schools (not just Catholic schools), we should not be afraid to pray that, once more, Ireland will be known as the Island of Saints and Scholars!

Prayer Reflection

Lord, we thank you that every once in a way you send people into our lives who shock us by showing us that we have been hiding behind the identity of the group we belong to.

They remind us of people who don't belong to our group, whom you have blessed, a humble widow who was visited by a great prophet, the leader of a different religious group whom you healed miraculously while we were left with our diseases.

It is a painful lesson, especially when it comes from someone within our own household, and we exclaim, 'This is Joseph's son, surely, what right has he to be teaching us?' But it is a moment of grace; we realise that we must stop looking down on people of other ethnic groups, of lesser education than ourselves; in this 'Year of Mercy' we must join members of other churches, religions and faiths, and unbelievers too, in asking for your mercy and forgiveness.
