3rd Sunday in Advent (Year C) 13th December 2009

*'The man who will come after me is much greater than I am....
I baptise you with water, but he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit.'*

There lived an extraordinary lamp lighter who was utterly reliable and punctual as a clock and who lived for one thing only....to light the lamps. At the onset of darkness each evening the gas lamps unfailingly came on. How he judged nobody knew because he had no watch.

His life was not an easy one but it glowed with meaning. He was loved by everybody, but especially by the children. When darkness threatened to put an end to their street games, he would come along, light the lamps, and they would continue to play.....such was his love for his job.

What was it that made him so extraordinary? After all, there are many people who love their work and who do it faithfully. His greatness lay in the fact that he was blind.....the man who was so faithful in bringing the light to others never saw it himself.

Eventually electricity arrived, and the "lamp man" now advanced in years, was made redundant. He felt useless and unwanted. Sadly the people, who once loved him, now forgot about him. The new light was so superior to the old that no one regretted its passing. He spent his days and nights alone in the

darkness of his basement flat.

Like the 'lamp man' John the Baptist worked diligently to bring his own light to the people, but he was always conscious of the fact that a greater light was coming, a light he himself was not destined to walk in. When the light appeared in the person of Jesus, he moved aside to make way for Jesus. That took greatness.

No person ever came to prominence or achieved fame on his own. You will always find that in the background there has been a facilitator whose task it was to help, guide and encourage them...in other words, to prepare the way for them. To make way, or even just to make room, for another person calls for humility and generosity of spirit.

Parents spend the best years of their lives preparing the way for their children, in the sense of opening them to life. But there comes a time when they have to withdraw and allow them to live that life. All of us are tempted to hug the limelight. We must try to shine to the best of our ability while being careful not to block the path for others and yet conscious of the debt owed to others who prepared the way for us.
