He served as Parish Priest of Cooleragh and Staplestown from 1993-2003. Fr. Pat was something of a wordsmith, with a wonderful capacity to put images together both, in the spoken and written word. The Parish of Cooleragh have just published what might loosely be called a 'Memoir' titled "Thoughts at Sundown"

Writing in the opening pages he explains: I never dreamed these little 'contributions' would end up in a booklet. I have chosen to give them the title 'Thoughts at Sundown', for two main reasons.

Firstly, almost all the articles were written after Sundown and sometimes more after the midnight hour. Secondly, I realised as a retired (due to ill health), P.P., morning and midday have passed for me.
