he blessed them. While he blessed them,
he parted from them."*

Possibly the most awesome and fantastic picture I have ever seen is the earth-moon shot taken by the Apollo astronauts. Emerging from behind the moon for the first time after entering lunar orbit, there in the foreground is the moon landscape. In the background, emerging from the blackness of space is the earth, 230,000 miles away.



How insignificant we as individuals appear from such distance. From this picture, we view our home as a round ball with deep blue oceans and swirling white cloud cover. Yet, how perfectly has this round ball, sitting in space, been made for us to inhabit. Once a day it turns around. Once per year it revolves around the sun. Night and day, cold and heat are thus precisely regulated. Our earth is tilted at 23 degrees so as it revolves, it gives us regular seasons and doubles the area upon which human life can live. Our creation for this place, and our home itself in the vastness of the universe, has been perfectly ordered, down to the most infinitesimal atom and life substance itself. We are not an accident, nor is our earth a creation of chance.

At God's right time, he visited his creation. Our planet had an Epiphany. God came, making himself known to us in Jesus Christ. Out of the vastness of his total creation, God cared enough to come. His mission: to reveal his loving Fatherhood, and to redeem us from ourselves. The Easter resurrection was his announcement. "Mission Accomplished!"

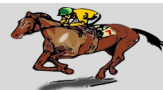
