I am the vine, you are the branches'

There is no such thing as a solitary Christian. Every Christian is linked to Christ and to all other Christians. This is clear from the words of Jesus 'I am the vine, you are the branches', which is a beautiful image of unity and closeness.

Jesus spoke these words to his apostle towards the end of the last supper; he foresaw that all of the disciples would abandon him; that Peter would deny him publicly; that Judas would betray him. Yet this was the night he chose to speak about unity and togetherness. Jesus foresaw that in spite of these upheavals, their unity would survive.

The apostles learned a lot about their own weakness and cowardice when confronted with the demands of unity and solidarity and they learned even more about Jesus; that he loved them in and through their weakness; if they should get separated from him, it would not be because he had cut them off. Far from being ended by the events of that night, their bond with Jesus was strengthened.

It is through facing struggle, failure, danger and sacrifice that unity grows and deepens. There is more depth to a relationship that has weathered some storms.

> We thank you Lord for the bond you formed with us. And thank you for the bond that exists among us because of our union with you.
