# Weekday <u>Summer</u> Schedule of Masses as follows:

## Courage! Do not be afraid.

Taken in a literal sense, the story of Peter attempting to walk on water may not be relevant for us; but taken symbolically it has great relevance for us. 'Walking on Water' is a symbol of something that is impossible to unaided human beings. There can be many situations in which we feel weak and powerless.

At some time or other we are all faced with very trying circumstances, very difficult decisions, very great sorrows, very powerful temptations. At those times it is as if we are being asked to 'walk on water'.

At those times we can draw courage from the example of Peter. Peter represents the typical disciple who is caught between faith and doubt. He set to obey Jesus, but 'as soon as he felt the force of the wind', that is, persecution, his faith failed him. Jesus rebuked, 'Man of little faith! Why did you doubt me?' is directed at us too. Like Peter, we often start out courageously only to lose heart when the going gets tough.

# Lord, when our faith falters, as it often does, may we hear your gentle voice saying to us, "Courage! Do not be afraid'.
