What am I sowing?

The farmer in today's Gospel sows his seeds lavishly. In fact, you could say that what he did was wasteful. He scatters seeds all over the place – on the edge of the path, on rock, on shallow soil, as well as on the rich soil. And he reaps what he sows. The rich soil produces a fine crop, but the rest of the seed produces nothing of value. It is lost.

When we listen to today's Gospel, it might be useful to compare ourselves to the farmer. All of us by the way we live sow seeds, and the seeds that we sow can be for good or ill.

What seeds are you sowing? What values, attitudes, and qualities are you planting in your children, in your family, your friends, work colleagues and community? What kind of witness are you for the Gospel message? What kind of harvest are you producing? The Gospel today invites us to ask these questions and to be honest in answering them.

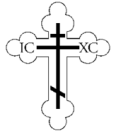
