

### The Widow's Mite... 2012

This week we heard of the enormous pensions some former bankers are receiving. One such banker made a voluntary cut to his pension, reducing it to a "mere" €250,000! It is important to remember that the bank in question is almost totally owned by the taxpayer. So it is the ordinary person on the street who is contributing to this pension! At the same time an 89 year old woman, who worked hard all her life, had her one hour of home help a week cut! The Gospel this week couldn't have come at a more apt time! Even in his time, Jesus could see the great inequalities in society. Despite the inequality the poor widow showed extraordinary generosity. The Gospel challenges us to reflect upon justice issues in our society today.

Serious injustices do exist within our society, as people who are inspired by the Gospel of Jesus Christ, surely we have to question these injustices. The Taoiseach and Minister for Finance tell us that these large pensions are protected by "contractual arrangements" and that they cannot do anything about them, it would require "constitutional change." Well let's have a referendum to allow the people voice their opinion on whether they want to bring about such change!

Even if the pensions were reduced, it would not make such a huge difference to our overall financial situation as a country, however this is not the point. The point is one of justice! How can we stand by as the vulnerable in our society (like the woman in the Gospel) take severe cuts while those, in positions of leadership and who acted irresponsibility, receive the reward of outrageous pensions
