The process of forgiveness

Jesus asks us to forgive 'seventy seven times', which means forgiveness, which is never easy, must be unlimited. Without the grace of God it is sometimes impossible.

When we get hurt, we naturally grow resentful and bitter. Resentment and bitterness are very dangerous things, and we cannot be healed of them unless we forgive. Forgiveness is a process, and like all processes it takes time.

We must recognise that a wrong has been done to us. We must recognise that we have feelings about this....feelings of anger and hurt. We should talk about these feelings. Then at some point we make a decision to forgive. Forgiveness is an act of will, but this doesn't mean that feelings of hurt and bitterness will suddenly disappear. The healing of these will take time.

We all need to forgive because at one time or another we all have been hurt. We need to pray for the gift of forgiveness. Unless we forgive we will not be able to let go of bitterness and resentment and so will not know peace or healing. Forgiveness doesn't mean forgetting. It means remembering and letting go. Only God can help us to accomplish it fully.

New Mass Responses; This weekend we begin our new mass responses as part of the revised Roman Missal introduction. There are cards available in the churches that highlight these new responses to be used during Mass and left at the end of seats after Mass.

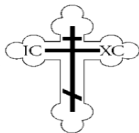
