#### THE CRY OF THE EARTH

To mark the Feast of St Francis of Assisi, (October 4th), the Irish Bishops Conference issued a new call to action for Climate Justice, entitled "The Cry of the Earth".

Trocaire, the Church's Development and Aid Agency, launched an excellent Pastoral Resource booklet to encourage and invite Christians to pray, study and act for Justice towards our world and universe.

While we in Ireland are embroiled in non stop discussions about new water charges, our world is in danger of serious water shortage, causing literally millions of deaths through starvation or disease. As Christians we have a duty to understand that we are only stewards of God's creation and to do what we can to treat all creation with respect and reverence as God's gift to all, not the chosen few.

Today's reading from Isaiah 25 expresses beautifully what God plans for us if we respect his generous and multiple gifts: "On this mountain the LORD of hosts will provide for all peoples a feast of rich food and fine wines". Meanwhile, always be thankful for the food and drink with which our Island home is blessed and for those who are harvesting it right now for our benefit.


