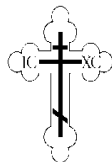

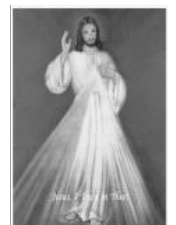

5. Sermon by Priest on Divine Mercy on the Feast Day.
