A few years ago I was visiting a primary school on a Friday afternoon. The principal was there with two little girls, they were no more than about seven or eight. It was quite obvious that they were after having a major falling out with one another and the principal was using her experience and well acquired skills over the years to try and help the situation. She was trying to persuade one of the girls to forgive the other for a hurt that was caused. After a long time little Mary said that she would forgive the other girl but it would be about next Tuesday before she could talk to her!

I thought it was one of those great examples of forgiveness. Forgiveness is difficult and even when we do achieve it, the hurt can linger on for quite some time. It might be possible to forgive, but it's not so easy to forget.

I remember being in school myself one day and having a falling out with another student. We were sulking, heads down, in bad form with one another. There was no way that one was going to give in to the other. So the teacher, in his wisdom, said to us; "For God's sake lads will you stop acting like adults!" Of course this brought a smile to our faces and things were sorted out. I think that teacher had his finger on the button, because very often adults do behave in an impossible manner. We can dig the heels in and there can be no moving forward.

Looking at our history as Irish people, there have been some terrible disputes between family members over land or business. Families have parted ways never to communicate again. Or in other cases people can fall out and then forever hold a grudge and any opportunity they get they use it to blacken the other's name. In cases like these, and we all know of them, bitterness can set in and can eat away at a person's peace.

In the Gospel today Jesus tells us that if we arrive before the altar and find we have something against our brother, go and sort the problem out with your brother first, then come back to the altar. How are you with this?
