Going into the desert...

On Wednesday we began the season of Lent which is our preparation for the Easter celebration of Jesus' resurrection. Excluding Sundays it is a season of forty days in imitation of Jesus spending forty days in the desert. Jesus fasted in the desert and overcame the devil's temptations. Jesus never sinned but in the desert he was tempted, and during these forty days of Lent we remember Jesus in the desert as we try to overcome temptation in our lives and to overcome sinfulness. There is practically no hiding place or shelter in the desert and the difficulties of the desert make whatever is inside a person come to the surface. The desert tests and shows up a person as he/she is.

Lent is an invitation to us to take the courageous step of "going into the desert" and not hiding from what lies hidden deep within us. Lent is a time to put our lives before a mirror and see ourselves as we really are. Lent is an invitation to allow our sin and our darkness and our wounds come to the surface so that we can deal with them and allow them to be healed by the grace of Jesus.

During these forty days of Lent, let us not hide from our sinfulness or prevent God speaking to us or healing us during this Lent. It is only when we admit something that we can deal with it. The first stage in overcoming anything is to admit the problem. If we remain in denial we miss out on the grace of God to heal us and renew us and make us whole.

The word "Lent" is an old English word which means "springtime." May this Lent really be a new springtime in the lives of each of us. Through prayer, fasting and almsgiving may we, like Jesus in the desert for forty days, overcome temptation and thus be well prepared to celebrate Easter.

Church Renovation:

Plans for the necessary renovation of Our Lady and St David's Church have been under consideration for a number of years. The display at the back of the Church outlines the proposed work. It has been divided into three phases:

Phase 1 consists of external works necessary to make the building weather proof—re-pointing, repair of roof and windows and replacement of defective guttering.

Phase 2 involves internal work—installing heating in the main porch and old mortuary chapel, re-positioning of tabernacle in the sanctuary area, provision of toilets accessible from the inside of the church, converting mortuary chapel into a vestry, upgrading of areas around the present sacristy, upgrading of electrical works and repainting of the interior.

Phase 3 consists of up-grading of church grounds and car park. The work has been considered by the finance committee, building groups and pastoral council.

It is recommended by all three groups that Phase 1 be completed this year and that it would be best to do Phase 2 at the same time. Phase 3 should be left to be considered at a later date. Luckily the parish has the finance to look after Phase 1. Phase 2 could be financed by a loan repayable over a number of years. The building & finance groups are preparing a fuller presentation on the project and will place it before parishioners, for their information, in the near future. In the meantime the necessary declarations and permissions will be sought from the local authorities.

We are all aware that these are very difficult times and finance is a problem for all development, especially voluntarily funded developments. As a parish we will have to devise a funding plan which is realistic and viable in light of today's economic circumstances.
