#### New Missal; New Translations:

The full new translation of the Mass will be introduced on the First Sunday of Advent, 27th November. This means that all of the Mass with the exception of the readings will be in a new translation which is considerably different from the English version currently in use. This change in translation is an opportunity for use to consider acquiring a Missal which we can use at Mass. A missal is also very useful for use at home in order to prepare for Mass by reading the scripture readings in advance. Last week some sample copies of Magnificat were available here in the churches. This comes in monthly volumes and contains the entire text of Mass for every day in the month along with morning and evening prayer. This is highly recommended for those who attend Mass every day. It is available by yearly subscription ( $\epsilon$ 45) from the Irish Catholic; contact Elaine McNamee at 01-4276486 or use the application form in the Irish Catholic.

The St Paul Sunday Missal is available for  $\[mathcal{e}$ 7.95 in Veritas Shop. This gives the full texts for all Sunday and Feast day Masses during the coming year from 27th November.

The CTS Sunday Missal will be available from Veritas in the new year. This will give the complete texts, including readings, for the three year cycle and so will not need to be replaced each year. Please consider the various options and acquire what best suits you.
