


The Meaning of Marriage

This 3rd Sunday of Advent we are invited to "Rejoice always", as brothers and sisters in Christ. Our Bishops have issued a beautiful pastoral letter on the Family, to remind us of the true meaning of family in the material and spiritual sense.

It is vital to understand that the Church is NOT against other legal definitions of relationships but insists that marriage, as contract and covenant (bonded in Christ), is the unique building block of stable society and must be preserved as such. Christmas is THE family season so we pray for the renewal of all families and for healing in families where there is burt or brokenness.



10th December 2014 - Vatican City: Dear Brothers and Sisters: This week we begin a new series of catecheses devoted to the family. As you know, the pastoral challenges involving the family were discussed in a recent meeting of the Synod of Bishops in preparation for the next Ordinary Assembly of the Synod in October, 2015. The meeting began with a very frank discussion of those serious challenges, in the light of the fundamental truths about the sacrament of

Matrimony – its indissolubility, unity, fidelity and openness to life. The fruits of this period of discussion and discernment were collected in a preliminary report, which was then discussed in smaller groups. The observations and suggestions which emerged were incorporated in a Final Report, which served as the basis for the Final Message of the Synod Fathers. The Final Report is being sent to the Bishops throughout the world, and the results of this consultation will be brought to the Synod meeting next October. I ask all of you to pray, through the intercession of Mary, Mother of the Church, that the Synod process will result in pastoral decisions truly beneficial to the family, the Church and society.
