Synod on the Vocation and Mission of the Family

As a follow up to the Synod held in Rome last October and in preparation for the second part, which will conclude next October, each diocese has received a set of questions for discussion and reply. Our diocese has set March 13th as the date for our replies to be in. From this sharing our bishops will draw up a document reflecting the views of the Irish Church which will be sent to Rome in April. This, in turn will feed into the document which will form the agenda for this most important Synod. It is the first time there has Mount St Anne's, Killenard.
