Where are you being called?

"Proposing vocations in the local Church" is Pope Benedict's theme for Vocations Sunday this year. The pope is anxious to remind us that the work of encouraging and promoting priestly vocations should be the concern of the whole Church, not simply those who fulfil the role of Vocations Director. In the Ireland of the past responsibility for encouraging vocations was generally fulfilled by the teaching religious; brothers and nuns. This, obviously, is no longer the case. Therefore the responsibility falls upon all our shoulders now to encourage more vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

In our diocese of Kildare & Leighlin we have seven students for the priesthood at various stages of their training. They are attending Maynooth and the Beda College in Rome. Overall there are over seventy students in Maynooth and approximately thirty studying for Irish dioceses abroad.

Jesus has a specific task in life For each and every one of us. Each one of us is hand-picked, Called by name by Jesus! There is no one among us that Does not have a divine vocation! Some are called audibly by God, But the usual kind of call is internal, Through the inner working of the Spirit. What is a vocation? It is an interior call of grace, Which falls into the soul like a seed, To mature within it.

Following my letter of the 1st May regarding the proposed renovation of Our lady and St David's Church and the suggestion that we could fund the work by adding an extra euro or two to our Sunday collections there has been an increase in the collections from the two churches in the parish.

Last weekend both collections increased to over \notin 4,000 for the first time since the beginning of January last. Thank you for your generous response to the appeal. If we are able to keep it up and even increase it then the funding of the project should be possible over the next four years or so.

There has been good positive feedback to the idea of the extra euro or two (or more!) in the collections; it is certainly easier than trying to sell/buy €100 draw tickets.
