## Transfiguration

Give up pettiness and treasure the blessings you have. Give up gloom and enjoy the beauty that is around you. Give up jealousy and pray for trust. Give up gossiping and take care in what you say. Give up sin and open yourself to the good news of the Gospel Give up giving up and instead hang in there as best you can!
