Divine Mercy Sunday: 1st May 2011

The feast of the Divine Mercy will be celebrated in the Church of Our Lady and St David, Sallins Road at 3pm on Sunday 1st May.

Preparation for the Feast should consist of:

- 1. Novena of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy commencing on Good Friday, 22nd April.
- 2. Confession on or before the Feast.
- 3. Holy Communion to be received on the Feast Day.
- 4. Acts of Mercy to be performed (by deed, word or prayer) on the days prior to the Feast Day.
- 5. Sermon by Priest on Divine Mercy on the Feast Day .
