In today's Gospel Jesus is in the wilderness. The Spirit drove Jesus out into the wilderness, therefore it is God who is in control here. With so much to do, we must take example from the first Sunday Gospel of this transforming season and allow ourselves to be led, like Jesus, 'into the wilderness'.


