An Interesting Parable for Today...

The parable of the weeds and the wheat is one of the most mysterious and yet practical of Jesus' parables. A farmer discovers that a poisonous weed, darnel, is growing amongst his wheat. This parable is found only in Matthew's Gospel and it may have been in response to a problem that bothered the early Church: how to explain the fact that there were both good and bad in the Church, that not all were saints. Some believed that the Church should consist only of good people, and that sinners, those who did not measure up, should be swiftly and ruthlessly weeded out. Jesus' message is that the sinner and the saint must live side by side.

But the message of the parable is particularly apt to us in the Irish Church today in the light of the publication of the Cloyne Report. Yet again we have discovered failures in Church practice to follow the highest standards with regard to the protection of children. This is very frustrating for all who have tried vigorously to implement these standards in our parishes. In relation to the failures of safeguarding children practice, which is a crime in civil law, the "darnel" must be rooted out so that our parishes are the safest of places for our children to grow in a healthy, loving and caring environment.
