Keep at it, don't give up!

Today Jesus tells a story to show how persistence pays off. A widow seeks justice against an enemy, and asks a judge to help her. The judge isn't interested in her case, however, and tries to ignore her. But she won't give up. She pesters him so much that in the end, in order to have peace, he gives in to her demands. Jesus is not saying that our heavenly Father is like the unjust judge. Rather, he is contrasting God with this unworthy magistrate. He is saying that if such a corrupt individual can be

forced to grant justice by sheer persistence, how much more is the God of love ready to look after our interests.

Having visited friends of mine recently with a baby, I soon realised that a baby knows how to get his or her way. Even though he or she may not be able to talk, they know how to communicate. They know how to get attention. Whatever it is they're looking for - whether it's a bottle or a change or simply to be picked up and embraced - they know that exercising their lungs will get them what they want. And if nobody seems to respond to their cry, they know that they should bawl all the louder. Even if it is only for the sake of peace and quiet, the infant usually wins out. He or she will get their way. Persistence will have paid off.

As adults we don't need to use these techniques to attract attention (well, hopefully not anyhow!) but we know the value of persistence. Many of the world's greatest writers achieved success only because they refused to give up in the face of rejection after rejection. Many of history's greatest artists, musicians and entrepreneurs got to the top only because they kept knocking on doors and refused to take no for an answer. We are to be persistent in our prayers also. Even when we think they are not being answered. God challenges us to persevere in prayer. We are not to give up. God will answer in his own way and in his own time. As Pope John Paul II said; "Through contact with Jesus in prayer, you gain a sense of mission that nothing can dull."
