FORGIVENESS

Today Peter speaks for many when he asks the question about forgiveness. Injuries of one kind or another are inflicted upon every person at times, and it is not unusual for one to experience injury at the hand of the same person more than once. The people of Peter's day had long since progressed beyond the "eye for eye, tooth for tooth" program for dealing with offenders. One was to forgive three times - not four times, but three times! But Peter had listened too closely to Jesus' teaching and had caught too much of his spirit to believe that he wanted

one to stop forgiving on the fourth offense. Maybe one should forgive seven times; that ought to be generous enough. So he asked Jesus if that would do. But Jesus replied, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy times seven."

So what is this forgiveness? Maybe its nature can be best seen in contrast to what it is not. It is not a casual or indifferent attitude toward wrong. When teaching of the obligation to forgive, Jesus was not saying that one should "pay no attention" to wrongs done... because the welfare of the one doing the wrong, as well as that of the one wronged, is involved. It makes a difference whether one's conduct is good or bad, and one should never face the evil conduct of another in such a way as to give the other the idea that it does not matter. So whatever else Jesus meant by forgiveness, he certainly did not mean indifference toward wrong.

So what did he mean, what is this week's challenge? Today's gospel asks us to see things in a new light, where the one who has been wronged is to be concerned for the welfare of the aggressor, as well as for one's own. And any demands which one makes for requital are not to be for compensation's sake, but for love's sake. Forgiveness cancels the desire to "pay the other person back" or "to get even" with him or her. We are called to forgiveness which must have no limits. It calls for the exercise of love, even towards the person by whom one has been injured, regardless of how seriously or how often. Are you up for the challenge?


