


# Church without Frontiers Mother to All.

Today we celebrate Immigrant and Emigrant Sunday throughout the church,, recalling the flight into Egypt, as refugees, of the Holy Family.

Pope Francis calls on all Christians to renew our faith in each other as God's children, sharing a common family bond in a world of ethnic and cultural diversity which should enrich all of us. Specifically we are invited, even commissioned, to "respond to the globalisation of migration with the globalisation of charity and cooperation, in such a way as to make the conditions of migrants more humane"

He goes on to say "Solidarity with migrants and refugees must be accompanied by the courage and creativity necessary to develop, on a world wide level, a more just and equitable financial and economic order, as well as an increasing commitment to peace, the indispensible condition for all authentic progress".

Today we pray for all Irish emigrants, in a special way, that they may be a leaven of goodwill wherever they are living and we also pray the we, as a nation, will make all immigrants as welcome as we hope other nations would welcome our sons and daughters.

May Christ, the infant refugee, bless all those living away from their homes at this time, whether by choice or necessity, and open our hearts to welcome the immigrant and refugee as we welcome Christ himself.



## The Meaning of Marriage - An Invitation

On 3rd December 2014 at Columba Centre, Saint Patrick's College, Maynooth, Bishop Liam MacDaid, chairman of the Council for Marriage and Family, along

with Bishop Kevin Doran, Bishop of Elphin, officially launched the pastoral statement 'The Meaning of Marriage on behalf of the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference'.

The pastoral statement advises the faithful that "to redefine the nature of marriage would be to undermine it as the fundamental building block of our society. The Church seeks with others to reaffirm ... that marriage should be reserved for the unique and complementary relationship between a woman and a man from which the generation and upbringing of children is uniquely possible."

The document was distributed through all our Churches over the Christmas period. In response to the issuing of this important document and in light of the upcoming referendum on Marriage, Fr PJ Madden and Deacon Fergal O'Neill will facilitate an open forum on the theme of 'Marriage' on Monday, 26th January at 8.15pm in the main hall of the Irish Martyrs Church in Ballycane. Questions / discussion will be an integral part of this meeting. All most welcome to attend.
