Pentecost - Happy Birthday!

Pentecost marks the birthday of the Church, therefore it's our birthday! In the readings we hear of the dramatic transformation that came over the disciples when the Holy Spirit came upon them. Their fear was banished and they went out to all to share the Gospel message.

This is dramatic stuff indeed, but for most people the Holy Spirit is hard to grasp. It is easier to have an image for the heavenly Father and the Son, but when it comes to the Spirit it is a bit more difficult. The Catechism of the Church tells us; the Spirit "draws" people to Christ. "He makes present the mystery of Christ, supremely in the Eucharist, in order to reconcile them, to bring them into communion with God, that they may 'bear much fruit.'"

Through the celebration of Pentecost (meaning "fifty"... fifty days after Easter), may we be drawn into full communion with God and may we live that relationship in a profound way in our daily lives.

Development Work on Our Lady and St. David's Church, Naas.

Over the past few years plans have been worked on to secure the external structure and upgrade the interior of Our Lady and St. David's Parish Church, Sallins Road. Below is the plan we will be following over the coming weeks and months. (*Please note this is for information purposes and may be subject to change, depending on aspects of tendering etc.*)

Our aim is that after the tendering process is complete, the building works would begin in early July. The approximate timescale for the works is four months. During this period Our Lady and St. David's will be closed and the masses and liturgies will be transferred elsewhere. The following is how we propose to manage these changes;
