The Prayer of the Heart

Today we see a great illustration of faith in the Gospel. Jairus is like many of us, when he is at his wit's end he turns to Jesus. The serious illness of his daughter brought him to the Lord. He was a parent who would have done anything for his child. It was crisis prayer. Jairus didn't have time for any pretence before Jesus, he shared what was on his mind and in his heart in an honest and open way. This is a good example of deep prayer. Crisis prayer brings us to God and hopefully when the crisis is over we are closer to God, and continue on the journey with God. It is good to pray in difficult times, but it is also good to continue prayer in more ordinary times.

Jairus' child may not have had faith, her father had enough for the two of them. That's why we pray for each other. When we are in crisis or difficulty we value the prayers of others. We grow in faith through the influence of the other person's prayer and our prayer effects the lives of others too. Sometimes our prayer can carry another person through a difficult time and give them the necessary strength needed. So we should never give up on prayer even when we feel it is not specifically answered. No prayer is unanswered. Prayer always encourages and makes us a bit stronger. Prayer works in God's time and this is a challenge always to our faith and love. The Lord sees the bigger picture we don't see.
