


Traditionally, May is Mary's month, a time set aside for particular devotion to the Mother of Jesus. It is an opportunity for us to think a little more about Mary, about her role in the Church, and what she has to say to us Christians.

Mary has always had a special and unique place in the Catholic Church. We see her, not only as the mother of God, but as our mother, who is close to us and intercedes for us. But devotion to Mary does not play the strong role in Catholic living that it did a generation ago. The Rosary and Angelus are no longer said in many Catholic homes, the May Altar and Processions are increasingly thing of the past. Fewer people visit Marian Shrines, or make Novenas to her honour. Whatever the reasons for the decline, it would be tragic if we stopped honouring Mary today, or pushed her to the periphery of our lives as Christians.

Because Mary is, in the words of the Second Vatican Council, "the Church's outstanding model in faith and love." She is our model because she shows us, better than anybody ever did, what it means to be a Christian.

Mary's whole life was a constant "yes" to God. When the angel Gabriel told her at the Annunciation of God's astonishing plan for her, she answered, "Be it done unto me according to thy word." No one, other than Jesus, has ever listened more willingly and responded more generously to God. That is why the Church honours Mary as first among the saints. She shows us what it means to listen to the word of God and keep it.


