### Hi There,

This is supposed to be an introduction, but can I tell you right at the start that no matter what I tell you, it'll only be partly true. You'll learn more of the truth about me from your own observations as we go along. So, here we go. My name is Declan and I was ordained in Kiltegan in 1973 and went to Kenya. I lived in various parts of it, in the desert, up the mountains and in a shanty town. In the late eighties I was asked to work in Armagh and stayed there for about seven years. I then went to Zimbabwe for a few years but was asked to take over a parish outside London, which I did. I spent some time at home as a chaplain in Vincent's in Dublin, while my mother was dying. After that I was invited to go and work in Newfoundland, in Canada, which I did for another seven years. Various surgeons have been chopping pieces off my back over the years - more so in recent years - so, I am not as agile as I used to be. I say that I suffer from what my mother and her side of the family gave me on my first birthday - arthritis! I'm sure many of you know what I am talking about.

I have experienced the Church in many forms and in some ways we are all the same, however in other ways we are very different. To a great extent the Church I have served has been a Church made up of people, not buildings. Often in Africa, when I went to say Mass, it didn't happen in a building. Often it would take place under a tree - if you were lucky. Sometimes the people got the shade and I had to stand out under the sun! But even that taught me a thing or two. As my mother would have said: it was good for me, in case I got notions of myself! I learnt to adapt and others had to adapt as well - people had to get used to me saying Mass in a floppy hat or under an umbrella. I don't think I'll have to do that around here.

Let me just say to you all, how touched I am at your welcome. You really are great and generous to a fault. Please, don't be too generous, because as you will see, doctors are trying to tell me to cut down on things. As you will see, I don't always do what I am told!! I am looking forward to getting my feet in under the table, for a few years and getting to know you.
