Mission Sunday:

Mission is done in hope. The farmer who sows seed, the baker who kneads leaven, must wait patiently for results. They must give up control. At the beginning, the outcome of their project may seem uncertain, unpromising, precarious. But the end result—large plants and many loaves —exceeds expectations. Today we join with God in sowing seeds of a new heaven and earth and look ahead, in hope, to the harvest of a new creation. And sometimes we even get a glimpse of that new creation when our mission projects bear fruit.

God already is at work among nations and peoples (Psalm 67, parables of seed and yeast), giving evidence of his will, salvation and judgment. The challenge of mission is discerning where and how God's Spirit is working in a particular time and place to bring peace and blessing and cooperating with it. Words are important to name what God is doing. Deeds are important to contribute to God's work.

God has a mission; not just saving souls, but bringing peace, salvation and blessing to the world.


