## **An Obvious Choice?**

At first glance, it seems a little surprising that Jesus should have chosen Simon Peter as the rock upon which to build his Church. After all, Simon did not seem as steady as a rock. He was headstrong and impetuous. He was a bit of a weak character. His faith faltered from time to time. He even denied Jesus. Jesus had to challenge him and rebuke him more than once. Even after Pentecost, St Paul felt it necessary to confront Peter, when he discovered that Peter had stopped eating with the Gentiles because of pressure from the Jews in Jerusalem; "When Cephas (Peter) came to Antioch, I opposed him to his face," Paul writes, "since he was manifestly in the wrong." (Gal 2:1)

And yet Peter was the one chosen by Jesus to lead the community in the future. Jesus was so confident in his choice that he could predict that the gates of the underworld would not prevail against his Church. Despite Peter's obvious frailty, Jesus' choice of first pope proved a wise one. Peter led the Church through the persecutions and difficulties of its first years with authority and courage, and died a martyr's death.

The fact that Jesus chose Peter, with all his weaknesses and frailties, to be the rock on which he built his Church should give us courage and inspiration. Jesus knew Peter wasn't perfect but he saw the potential in him. He saw the goodness in him. Jesus sees the potential and the goodness in each one of us too. Do we see it in others?
