# "Peace be with you"

When we are not expecting it to happen, even a good event can startle us. So it was with the disciples when Jesus appeared to them. He sought to calm them when he said, "Peace be with you" and he helped them to see the good news behind what had initially alarmed them. He helped the disciples to find new hope, but he did not give them easy answers. He asked them to see the facts before their eyes. He wanted them to learn from the lived experience they were having.

Who has been a Jesus person for us by helping us to find meaning and good news in life? As a parent, guardian, teacher, friend or guide have we been a Jesus person to another, helping him/her to find hope and purpose in life by learning from his/her experiences? Who has done this for us?

The resurrection experience empowered the disciples to be witnesses; unexpected possibilities for the future surfaced when it seemed that hope had gone. When have new possibilities opened for us after a 'resurrection' experience; recovery of health when it did not seem possible, new opportunities after failure or disappointment, inner healing after deep hurt?

Lord Jesus, don't walk ahead of us, we may not follow; don't walk behind us, we may not lead; just walk beside us and be our friend. "Peace be with you"
