Time Out.....

Sometimes we all need to take a step back from the routine of our daily lives. It's good to take time to reflect upon where we are at in life. This was important for Jesus too. Many times in the Gospels we hear of him taking time to be by himself to pray to his heavenly Father. This First Sunday in Lent we hear of him going out into the desert. Jesus needed this time of retreat to find his focus in his life. We need the same to define the goals of our life. We need time and space to hear the call to give quality time to marriage, to use the things of creation well, to avoid what's detrimental to health and soul, to treat everyone with the dignity that is their due, to respect the other in our friendships, to respect each other on the roads, and to care for the environment. This is all part of the goal of being a Christian.

This sense of going out into the "desert" has been very much part of our tradition. We have places such as Glendalough, Croagh Patrick, Lough Derg where people have journeyed to find peace and solitude down through the centuries to this day. We may not be able to afford the luxury of taking a day or two in Glendalough to be by ourselves this Lent, but perhaps there are other things we could do that could make a difference;

- We could take a few extra minutes to pop into the church to enjoy some quiet time of reflection in the presence of the Lord.
- We could take a walk and look all around and reflect upon the gifts God has blessed us with in creation, things that perhaps we take for granted.
- We could take time to thank God for all he has blessed us with in life... family, health, home, friendships...
- We could sit quietly with a piece of Scripture and reflect on what the Lord might be saying to us in it.

Lent offers us endless opportunities to strengthen our bond with the Lord and one another!
