### Catholic Schools: Places of Faith and Learning

Catholic Schools Week 2014 begins today (Sunday, 26th January). This is the sixth year of celebrating the wonderful contribution that our Catholic schools, both primary and post-primary, make to the mission of the Church in our local faith communities and throughout the wider Church. It is only fitting that we take this opportunity to celebrate that work when we gather as a worshipping community at the beginning of Catholic Schools Week. Our own Bishop, Denis Nulty launched Catholic Schools Week on Monday last. During his address he emphasised a number of important points around Catholic education. Firstly he outlined what is at the heart of Catholic education, he said; "Catholic Schools are the key to a life lived with Christ at its centre. The key to a future built on a firm foundation of faith and hope. The key to a culture and society shaped with justice and integrity."

In addressing the young people present at the launch of Catholic Schools Week, Bishop Denis said that "It is here that you grow in your knowledge of Jesus Christ and come to realise that He is always with you helping you to achieve what is best for you. Pope Francis recently said to a group of teachers: "Jesus does not say: 'Go, make do'. No! Jesus said: 'Go, I am with you'." This is at the heart of the Christian message."

Bishop Denis went on to further quote Pope Francis when he reminded us of what the Pope said a few months ago; "Education is a key, key mission." Note the emphasis!!! Our Catholic schools are key to the mission of the Church. Schools are called to be places where we witness to the world by doing and acting differently. They are places where we proclaim Christ to all. Is it any wonder that Pope Francis calls education "a key mission"?

As a Catholic community may we continue to support the work and effort that is carried out in our schools. We give thanks to the Boards of Management, principals, teachers and staff that work so hard in our schools to hand on the faith in a changed and changing culture.


