Catholic Schools Week & Year of Faith

The theme for Catholic Schools Week 2013 is: "Catholic Schools in the Community of Faith: Sharing the Good News." Catholic Schools Week 2013 will be mindful of two major subjects for the year 2013 (a) Year of Faith and (b) Share the Good News. The theme of Catholic Schools Week 2013 reflects both. CSW 2013 begins, today, January 27th. The Year of Faith, declared by Pope Benedict, is an opportunity for Catholic schools to recommit themselves to strengthening and celebrating their Catholic identity.

The *Year of Faith* began on 11th October 2012, the 50th anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council and the 20th anniversary of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* and will end on 24th November 2013, the Feast of Christ the King. This time will provide Catholics locally and throughout the world an opportunity to celebrate, deepen and share the richness of their Catholic faith.

With this in mind, as part of the Year of Faith in Naas, the Parish Pastoral Council have organised a *Festival of Light and Hope!* This begins on Thursday coming, 31st January at the 7.30pm Mass and continues during the 7.30pm Mass on the following two nights. The topics and speakers are as follows:

Thursday; "Faith – Why Bother?" with Fr. Eugene Curran (All Hallows College).

Friday; "Faith in the Family" with Breda O'Brien (Irish Times Columnist).

Saturday; "Healing our Hearts" with Fr. Liam Lawton (Singer & Author).



The three celebrations are designed for all of us who are on the faith journey, whether we are strong in faith or struggling with faith. It might be of particular interest to parents trying to hand on the gift of faith to their families and those parents who have children for sacraments this year. Please note that everyone is welcome, so tell your friends and neighbours to come along! Simple refreshments will be served after each Mass each evening.

St Brigid's Day.....Friday 1st February:
