Sharing the Lord's Mission

From September to October last year, 13 meetings were held throughout our diocese of Kildare and Leighlin. The task was to discuss the proposal to group parishes into Pastoral Areas and to give people the opportunity to react to the first draft of the map detailing these proposed Pastoral Areas. Our own Pastoral Area comprises of the parishes; *Naas, Sallins, Two Mile House, Kill and Ardclough.* People from these parishes met at an open meeting on the 27th of September, 2010 in Ballycane. We had a great response, with well over one hundred people in attendance. The Pastoral Area model is trying to encourage more sharing of resources around ministry between these parishes as the number of priests decline. It is a challenging area with no clear map for the way forward.

A summary report has now been published, emerging out of the 13 proposed Pastoral Area meetings. This report can be accessed on our parish website; www.naasparish.ie or our diocesan website; <a href="www.naasparish

In early April the Parish Pastoral Councils of Naas, Sallins, Two Mile House, Kill and Ardclough will meet to reflect upon the report and try to work out ways of how we can work more closely together as a Pastoral Area. Since we await the appointment of a new bishop, this new proposed "model" of Pastoral Area cannot be formally sanctioned. However it is important that we try to take steps to face the challenges ahead. This is new territory for us all. We ask the Spirit of the Lord to guide and inspire us as we try to respond to his call and share in his mission in theses changed and changing times.

GARMENT OF PAIN The season of Lent is upon us once more and for many people the year just passed will be remembered perhaps not with fondest memories. Some have been bereaved, others have been separated from someone they love and many have known their own share of pain.

We invite the people of the Parish to join in the Garment of Pain by placing a small piece of cloth, no bigger than a postcard, which represents a sadness in their lives, into the baskets in the Churches. In the final days of Lent these pieces of cloth will be sewn together to form one Garment which will be used as the altar cloth at the Mass of the Last Supper on Holy Thursday and will be draped on the cross, as the act of solidarity with all those who suffer, on Good Friday. When we burn our Garment in the fire of the Easter Vigil we make a bold gesture of Hope in the Risen Christ who has conquered death.
