


Money Matters:

Just to keep you in the picture as to where your contributions go.

Regular Sunday Mass — Two Collections (Naas).

First Collection — Building/Development Fund

This fund is used to service the debt for the restoration of the Church of Our Lady and St David. A share of it is used for maintenance of the Church of the Irish Martyrs and parish houses/offices. Surplus will be used for further development of our parish.

Second Collection, known as the Offertory Collection.

It funds the day to day running of our parish e.g. insurance, heat, lighting, sacramental, offices, grounds, cleaning, security, repairs, diocesan levy, wages (other than priests). The Sunday collection in Sallins and Two Mile House is an offertory collection used for the same purposes, as above, for both parishes.

Special Collections e.g. Mission Sunday, Peter's Pence, Trocaire special appeals, Retired Priests are lodged to our charitable donations account for our three parishes and distributed appropriately.

Clergy Fund:

This is the fund out of which we, the priests, are paid monthly.

The fund consists of:

Christmas Day and Easter Sunday — all monies collected.

Five designated Sundays e.g. Lent, Summer, Autumn. On these Sundays a share of the offertory collection (i.e. whatever is above the average) along with special envelopes.

Offerings for November List of the Dead.

Baptism offerings in full. Wedding offerings less €50 retained by the celebrant of the day.

Standing Orders from those who contribute in this way.

Out of this we are paid monthly: Parish Priest €1,900. Curate €1,750. Upon reaching 65 (if in receipt of state pension) €1,500. Should excess monies remain in the fund they are directed to a central diocesan fund to support priests where the local clergy fund falls short of standard payment. This follows normal practice throughout our diocese.

On this Easter weekend we thank you for your on-going support and generosity which is never taken for granted and always appreciated.
