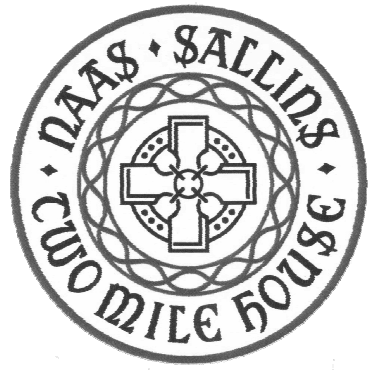

For the evening sessions, we offer a child centred creative zone at the back of the Church of Our Lady and St. David where the message of the Mission will be communicated at an age appropriate level through stories and other activities.
