THE ROSARY: Wednesday coming, 1st October, the Feast of St Therese, The Little Flower, begins the month of The Rosary, dedicated to Mary, Mother of the Church and all families.

The Rosary is a powerful and simple way to share a few minutes a day with our Mother and her Son, through praying a mystery or a decade as we sit quietly, drive, or walk along the road, or even potter in the kitchen, garden or field. It offers consolation to those who are sick or in bed by sharing with Mary a reflection on a moment in Christ's childhood, mission, suffering or glory. Any of the 20 mysteries may be prayed on any day.

Praying the Rosary is like having a chat with our Mother about our day and it's ups and downs! And, like all good mothers, our heavenly Mother always wants to hear from us.
