Working with love

The performance of a duty, even the faithful performance of such, can result in a withering of the heart when one is not motivated by love. Two people can be doing the same work, even working side by side and yet bring contrasting attitudes to it.

One, the shepherd, loves his work and has made a total gift of himself to it.....it is a way of life, a vocation. He knows his sheep and cares about them to the point that he is prepared to risk his life to save them. The sheep thrive as a result. The other, the hireling, hates his work, and is at best only half-hearted.....for him it is only a job. He doesn't know his sheep or care about them. The sheep suffer as a result.

All work is empty save when done with love. And what is it to work with love? It is to weave the cloth with threads drawn from your heart, even as if your beloved were to wear that cloth. It is to build a house with affection, even as if your beloved were to dwell in that house. If you cannot work with love but only with distaste, it is better that you should leave your work, and sit at the gate of the temple and take alms from those who work with joy. For if you bake bread with indifference, You bake a bitter bread that feeds but half of man's hunger. and if you grudge the crushing of the grapes, your grudge distils a poison in the wine. Work with love made visible.
